We will need to do more to increase the number of individual donors. I feel that standing orders may be a good way to maintain continuity.

Publications Sales None yet.

Journal of Graduate Education income None yet.

Other This comprises several matters:

A credit of £73.20 from the Bank of Scotland which was accrued on a now cancelled credit card.

Several payments totalling £952 from *News International* that were made by BACS. A phone conversation established that some of the earlier payments were due to an error in their finance office codes. I requested an invoice for reimbursement but have yet to receive it.

A 2p overpayment by an outstanding debtor from previous years on a keep the change basis.

Income total We're £4396.72 ahead of the nominal target and have exceeded our total target for the year.

Expenditure

Salaries Almost on rounded target.

Travel & Subsistence There is a significant overspend here. The main cause of this is the need to pay travel expenses for the EuroDoc conference when their regular source of funding fell through late in the day, resulting in member organisations being asked to aid travel expenses. Also with the last two months of the year traditionally more office bound than most (due to Conference) for the General Secretary the overspend should decrease.

Executive Expenses A £291.28 overspend, mainly due to accommodation at the Cranfield general meeting.

Office Expenditure in general Still very little – Simon can update on how generous BUGS are (but check for bugs first!)/what has still to be claimed for.

Publications expenditure There has been a noticeable overspend here, covering a large order of headed paper (5000 sheets) which will last for some time yet. This was authorised as it works out cheaper in the long run.

Journal of Graduate Education Expenditure Nothing spent yet.

NPC Conference 2005 Duncan has the various figures – a combination of illness and travel meant that between us we have yet to marry the figures. We are aiming to meeting this coming week to sort out the remainder for invoicing. Expenditure wise the most recent bill was for room hire and printing facilities. VAT was included (£222.82) which has been paid upfront but I have formally queried this to see if we can be reimbursed.

Committee Meetings i.e. Ordinary General Meetings. These are expected to break even. We will need to claim back from attendees' institutions for the accommodation for the Essex OGM.

Scottish Subcommittee i.e. NPC Scotland. Nothing spent yet.

Welsh Subcommittee i.e. NPC Wales/PCÔ-R Cymru. Nothing spent yet.

Other day seminars and meetings Nothing spent yet.

Attendance at Conferences This comprises of a single fee for a stand at the NUS Conference, now paid in full.

Audit Paid after the end of the year.

Affiliations Paid £6.00 to the Scottish Youth Hostels Association. The Scottish Council for Voluntary Organisations membership goes out later in the year.

Insurance £88.06 under – virtually hitting the rounded target.

Bank Charges/Interest & JGE Interest We have had one charge of £20 for taking out the credit cards and £6 for withdrawing cash for the EuroDoc trip (when Simon and I went to the Bureau De Change in Russell Square we were told it would be cheaper to buy Euros with cash than credit card).

Otherwise we are significantly ahead of target here. In part this is because the interest reflects the amounts in the accounts at any point and these have increased a bit in successive years, but also this is the first full year in which the main account has had a much more favourable rate of interest.

Other The £500 payment is for the International Students Festival, as voted for by the November Ordinary General Meeting.

Contingency Nothing spent due to contingencies not yet having arisen.
